## Indiana Arts Commission Region 10 Arts Initiative Grants Presentation

*January 2018, Evansville*—An event to present the Indiana Arts Commission (IAC) Regional Arts Initiative Grants for FY2018 will be held Thursday, January 18, 2018, beginning at 4 p.m. at the Arts Council of Southwestern Indiana, 318 Main Street, in Evansville.

Grants totaling \$144,597 to 23 regional arts organizations and arts programs (listed below) will be presented during this event. These grants are awarded through IAC's Region 10 arts partner, the Vanderburgh Community Foundation, an affiliate of the Community Foundation Alliance of Evansville.

The IAC Region 10 area includes the counties of Daviess, Dubois, Gibson, Knox, Perry, Pike, Posey, Spencer, Vanderburgh, and Warrick in southwestern Indiana.

In addition to recipients, as well as staff of the Foundation and Alliance, the District Director of US Senator Todd Young's office, Brenda Goff, representatives from the office of Congressman Larry Bucshon, MD, and Evansville Mayor Lloyd Winnecke will be on hand. **Media is invited and welcome to attend.**
