WOMEN'S FUND OF WARRICK COUNTY AWARDS \$14,600 IN FUNDING TO NONPROFITS

Warrick County, Indiana – The Women's Fund of Warrick County, a fund of the Community Foundation Alliance, has awarded \$14,600 in total grant awards to nonprofit organizations working to improve the quality of life for Warrick County families. The Women's Fund grants committee selects recipient organizations annually to receive a portion of the funds' earnings, in the form of grant awards.

Encountering Hope Ministries to support the GAIN Initiative designed to move Warrick County residents out of poverty
